1. The 4/21/22 EHC meeting was opened by Chairman J. Holden Camp Jr. at 2:06 p.m.

2. Minutes:

The minutes of the 3/15/22 meeting were moved for approval by Marca Daley, seconded by Sylvia Sullivan and unanimously approved.

3. Old business:

- a. Abbott Award: Marie Forjan reported two additional candidates were contacted by letter for consideration for the Abbott Award. One was very excited to be considered but asked that the EHC contact them in 2025 as they will be doing extensive work on the house for the next three years. The other candidate has yet to respond. A third candidate, previously contacted, will be back on Cape in May or June and Marie Forjan will contact them then to set up a tour of their home.
- b. There was discussion about reviving a project that was put on hold due to COVID of making a display explaining what the Abbott Award is and showing past recipients. This would be made available for the Library to post as well as the Eastham Historical Society.
- c. J. Holden Camp Jr. reviewed the procedure for an Eastham resident to apply for a permit to demolish a historic structure of 75 years or older. He has an upcoming meeting with members of various departments at Town Hall to ensure these procedures are clearly understood.
- d. J. Holden Camp Jr. reported his conversation with the new Town Assessor. She said she is open to adding two fields to property assessment cards that will allow anyone looking at them to see if there is a "Form B" for a property and/or if a property is in a "Historic District".
